In this lesson we learn the number from 3 to 10 with feminine ma'dûd. We have already learnt these numbers with masculine ma'dûd, e.g.

Three sons لَلاَتُهُ أَبْنَاء

Now if the ma'dûd is feminine, the "ta-marbûtah" (5) at the end of the number is omitted, e.g.

three daughters أَرْبَعُهُ أَبْنَاءِ three daughters أَرْبَعُ أَنْوَاتٍ three sons أَرْبَعُ أَخُوَاتٍ four sisters أَرْبَعُ أَخُوَاتٍ four sons خَمْسُ أَمَّهَاتٍ four sons خَمْسُ أُمَّهَاتٍ six men سَتُّةُ رِجَالٍ six women سَبْعُ طَالِبَاتٍ seven lady students سَبْعُ طَالِبَاتٍ eight rooms تَمَانِيْ غُرَفٍ eight rooms

Note that تَمَانِي has sukun on the last letter.

ten men عَشْرَةُ رِجَالٍ عَشْرُ نِسَاءٍ ten women

has sukun. عَشْرُ has fatha on the (ش) and عَشْرَةُ has sukun.

nd of اِثْنَتَانِ is اِثْنَتَانِ and of وَاحِدَةٌ and وَاحِدَةٌ , e.g. لِثُنَتَانِ أَنْنَانِ أَخْتُ وَاحِدَةٌ / لِي أُخْتَان اثْنَتَان .
